Toni Lewis is a Community Coach at County Health Rankings & Roadmaps, a collaboration of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and the University of Wisconsin Population Health Institute. Her role is to provide guidance to leadership teams working together to adopt programs, policies, systems, and environmental changes to create healthier places to live, learn, work, and play.

She worked as a Project Director for the Greater Mercer Public Health Partnership, where her interest in working with communities in Mercer County, New Jersey began.
